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**Week 1 Assignment: March 30 - April 3:**

Students in sixth grade will be receiving a packet called “The African Lion”. On the school website, it can also be found in the link Grades 6 - 7. This packet will include assignments for ELA, Math, Science, and Social Studies. The last page of the packet will have a rubric explaining which pages will be assigned for each subject area.

For language arts, the students will be asked to complete pages 25 and 26 in the packet. Then they will need to write a two page narrative story of their own. The first worksheet (page 25) will explain what a narrative is and ask questions about the story read in the packet. The second page will ask the students to do a prewriting activity for planning a narrative story they will write. After filling out the organizer, the students will write a two page double spaced narrative story of their own. The rubric on the last page of the packet I have also listed below.

### **Turn in your assignment:**

-if you typed your assignment as a google doc, turn it into google classroom.

-If you are not able to use the internet to type your narrative, write it out neatly on notebook paper. Keep it in a safe place until we know the procedure for returning it to the school.

### **Completing the assignment in Google Classroom:**

If using google docs:

1. Create/Add a google doc before beginning the assignment.
  - A. Click on Create/Add
  - B. Select Google docs
  - C. You should see it downloading a blank document.
  - D. You will then click on this assignment when typing your paper.This will save the assignment automatically in google classroom.  
Then when finished, you will only have to remember to click turn in.
  
2. If you forgot to add/create a google doc before starting the assignment, you will need to add/create your narrative at the end.
  - A. When ready to turn in the assignment, click add/create.
  - B. Click on google drive. In your drive, click on the assignment.
  - C. A blue ADD button will appear. Click on ADD.
  - D. You will see your document downloading into your classroom.
  - E. Once it's done downloading, you will click on TURN IN. It will ask you to do this twice.\*\* Be sure to follow step B. You must click on google drive in the drop down menu so you can add your document from your drive. Do not click on google docs from the down menu. It will
