***GAME DAY PROTOCOL Winter 2020-21***

**Spectators**

- Covid-19 symptom self assessment prior to arrival
- Sanitize hands prior to entering facility
- Must be wearing a mask
- Must present voucher in order to purchase a ticket
- Must sit with family members in order to help maintain social distancing.
  
- Spectators Capacity
  - Capacity is based on the Governors and the State Department of Health Mandate that we must not exceed 15% capacity of fixed seating capacity.
  - *We will not be able to use our elementary gymnasium due to this low capacity (all MS and HS Basketball and Wrestling events games will be played at the HS gym this season. If events must be played in the elementary gym we may not be able to have spectators at those events)*
  - Vouchers will be given to home team participants and visiting team participants to allow for family members to purchase tickets at the home site. These numbers are pre-determined to stay under the state ordered capacity limitations.
  - For the Winter Season **the Vouchers will be on Card Stock and Should be kept and reused for each Home and Away Games by family members. Replacements will not be issued.**
  
- Varsity Girls and Boys Basketball Events: 4 vouchers for each home participant, and 2 vouchers for each visiting participant.
- Middle Girls and Boys Basketball Events: 4 vouchers for each home participant, and 2 vouchers for each visiting participant.
- Wrestling Events: 4 vouchers for each home participant, and 2 vouchers for each visiting participant.
- Coaches will distribute a voucher to athletes to bring home. ***Example: The Athletic Director will distribute the Home and Away vouchers to coaches/supervisors, who will then distribute the allotted amount to their athletes. The voucher must be presented at the event in order to be able to purchase a ticket for admittance to the contest.***
- ***NO general admission tickets will be sold at the door.***
- ***Family Members should keep these Home and Away vouchers to use for each home game and each Away game***

**Fan Expectations**

- Each family will only receive the allocated number for that family.
- Seating will be marked off with tape to indicate seating areas to maintain social distancing.
- Families are expected to sit together.
  - This will allow more space for social distancing from other spectators.
- There will be no Student Section allowed. Students should sit with family members

- All Spectators attending events in the gym must remain in the gym.
- Firelands Conference and OHSAA passes are the only passes accepted. All other passes will not be accepted. No other passes will be sold this winter.
- Individuals not wearing a mask will not be admitted. Any spectator who does not wear a mask during the event may be asked to leave the facility.
- Ticket prices: Varsity game \$6.00, lower level \$5.00 for adult and \$3.00 for student.
- No additional general admission tickets will be sold.
- No student pre-sale tickets, and no passes will be sold.
- Gates will open 45 minutes prior to the start of High School Events
- Gates will open 30 minutes prior to MS Basketball and 9th grade basketball events.
- **At the conclusion of the game all fans and teams, coaches, etc. must exit the facility immediately. No team gatherings or parents waiting for students inside the facility.**
- No re-entry into the facility.

### **Compliance Personnel**

- Western reserve will have compliance personnel at home games
- Game administrators, Police Security, and compliance personnel will help to monitor and remind spectators of the mandates and guidelines

### **Sanitation**

- Hand Sanitizer will be available in the facility

### **Arrival Time**

- Ticket gates will open 30 minutes prior to Middle School and 9th grade games
- Gates will open 45 minutes prior to JV and Varsity games.

### **GAME CONCLUSION**

- At the conclusion of the game all parents, fans, teams and coaches must exit the facility immediately. No team gatherings or parents waiting for students inside the facility.
- No re-entry into any facility.

### **CONCESSIONS**

- Concessions may be limited.
- Fans are encouraged to bring bottles of water to home games if they so choose.
- There are bottle fillers available in the HS at drinking fountains
