Criteria

1. Given to one senior male and female.
2. Male student must have a 2 year letter in football and in track.
3. Female student must have a 2 year letter in track and another sport (excluding cheerleading).
4. Must have a 2.0 GPA
5. Recipient must possess the following qualities:
 - a. Work attitude on the field and in the classroom
 - b. Leadership
 - c. Citizenship
 - d. Sportsmanship
 - e. Commitment
