Preferences will be given to those applicants pursuing a degree in education, engineering, construction management, social work or agriculture.

Qualifications

1. Applicant must have a GPA of 2.5 or higher.
2. Applicant must exhibit outstanding leadership qualities.
3. Applicant must have performed community service.
4. Applicant must show evidence of part-time or summertime employment or entrepreneurship.
5. Applicant must be involved in extra-curricular activities (athletics, band, choir, FFA, FCCLA, student council, etc.)
