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Dear Parents/Guardians,


In May, the United States Department of Education granted Ohio relief from several federal education regulations contained in the Elementary and Secondary Education Act, commonly referred to as "No Child Left Behind." Two of the regulations that were affected are Public School Choice (PSC) and Supplemental Education Services (SES). At Western Reserve Elementary School, we are dedicated to our students and their families, and would like to take the opportunity to explain the changes.

Prior to the changes, schools were required to offer students that attended schools identified as "School Improvement" (SI) the option of transferring to another school within the district with transportation (PSC) or before and/or after school tutoring (SES). Western Reserve Elementary School has routinely provided before/after school tutoring in the past, and plans to continue doing so this school year.

Our plan to support student achievement is a multi-factored approach. First, grade-level teacher teams are meeting weekly to analyze student progress data in order to refine classroom interventions. Additionally, students in grades 4-6 that have been identified as struggling with math concepts will have the benefit of a math tutor during the school day. Finally, after the results of practice achievement data is analyzed, before/after school tutoring will be offered in both Reading and Math.
