AIMS and SAT10

Arizona's Instrument to Measure Standards (AIMS) is a test given once a year in April to all students in Arizona at grades three through eight. It measures state standards and schools are given achievement labels based on the results of this exam.

Quarterly Benchmark Assessments

Wilson students take a quarterly benchmark test, a criterion referenced test or CRT, to test progress on the Arizona State Standards. Every nine weeks a Reading and a Math assessments are given and a Writing sample is taken for all students in grades 2-8.

Chapter Tests

Students in grades K-3 also take chapter tests to measure their understanding of reading and math instruction.

Dibels

Dibels is a series of one-minute oral tests to measure students' literacy. Tests measure alphabet fluency, phonics, and reading comprehension.
