COMMUNITY—The community of Lander is located in a valley in the Wind River Mountains. The population is 7,732 with major industries and resources of mining, petroleum, and agriculture. The leading employer in the area is the State of Wyoming.

SCHOOL DISTRICT—The district educational system includes a K-12 program: one K-3 school, one 4-5 school, one 6-8 middle school, one alternative 9-12 school, and one traditional 9-12 high school. The end of the year district population was 1,742 students.

SCHOOL—Lander Valley High School is a four year comprehensive high school with a August 27, 2020 enrollment of 547 students. Native American students make up 13% of the LVHS population. Expenditures per ADM for the 2019-20 school year were \$7,519.27.

FACULTY—Of the 41 certified staff, 28 hold a Master's Degree. The student to teacher ratio is 16 to 1, with 34 full-time classroom teachers.

Accreditation

Lander Valley High School is accredited by the North Central Association of Secondary Schools, and a member of National Honor Society, National Forensic League, and National Student Councils.

Students must earn a minimum of 25 credits to graduate from Lander Valley High School.

Schedule System

LVHS operates on a modified block schedule. Students take seven classes per semester.

TESTING DATA

The State of Wyoming requires of all juniors the ACT. Freshmen and Sophomores are required to take the WY-TOPP test. Fremont County School District One requires the STAR test for 9th and 10th graders. Optional assessments include the PSAT/NMQST and ASVAB.

*There's no ACT Date for 2020 due to the COVID shutdown.

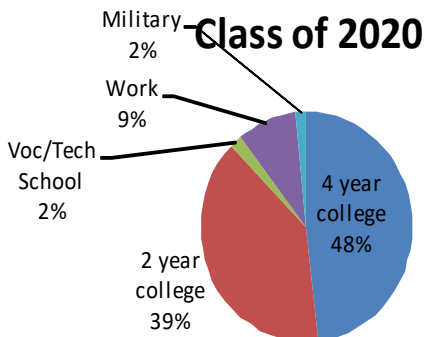
Extra- and Co-Curricular Opportunities
