Dear Parent or Guardian,

The Food Service Department would like to notify you of how our cafeteria works at LVHS for students. LVHS is our only school that has the sale of Ala Carte items.

- Such items are **NOT** part of a regular school lunch. If your student does **NOT** have funds available, either money in their lunch account, or cash in hand, **they will not be allowed to purchase or charge any ala carte items.**
- A regular school breakfast cost \$1.50 per day. This includes; 1 entrée serving, fruits, grains & milk.
- A regular school lunch cost \$2.75 per day. This includes; 1 entrée serving, fruits, veggies, grains & milk.
- Ala Carte items range in prices from \$.25 to \$2.50 and include, but aren't limited to the following; the purchase of an extra entrée serving, granola bars, whole grain snack crackers, cheese sticks, yogurt, low-fat ice cream bars, frozen fruit bars, bottled water, bottled juices, etc.

Please discuss this with your student. We encourage you to view Parent Portal, to keep track of your students daily spending. You may also make payments online to your students lunch account via Parent Portal, but you can always send cash, check or money order to school. Credit/debit card payments may be made via your Parent Portal, at the schools front office or contacting the Food Service Director.

Lunch accounts that are more than 30 days negative may be turned over to a collection agency. Reduced and Free meals are available with qualifying application. This does not apply to reduce the cost of ala carte items, only on a regular school lunch or breakfast. Applications are available at any of our Lander schools, online through your Parent Portal or printable off of the district website at www.landingschools.org.
