## THE ART OF FLY TYING

An introduction to the “Art” of Fly Tying, in an effort to draw more people to the sport of fly fishing. The course is open to everyone; no one is too young or too old. The class will start with the basic fundamentals, with the intent of having the students create a fly pattern which will actually catch fish. The patterns that will be demonstrated are those which are used in Wyoming (North Platte and Mountain Streams).

During each session, approximately three different patterns will be tied.

**REQUIRED SUPPLIES:** A fly tying bobbin and a spool of 8/0 brown or olive tying thread, a pair of scissors and if possible, a fly tying vise.

If you do not have these supplies, they will be available in the class. The instructor will provide all other tying materials, including hooks, feathers, fur and any specialized gadgets.
