

SMETHPORT SCHOOL DISTRICT 2020 FALL TICKET GUIDELINES (10.7.20)

- Currently, we are under new amended orders for targeted mitigation for events and gatherings. Given the guidelines on permissible spectator numbers and social distancing requirements, we have determined limits at 500 for our stadium and 125 for our gymnasium. These numbers include participants and spectators.
- Tickets are event/game specific and tickets are complementary.
- Tickets will be given to student participants. Participants may include players, cheerleaders, band members as applicable.
- In general, fans and spectators from visiting teams are NOT permitted, so please do NOT plan to attend away events unless you are notified otherwise.
- All people entering the parking lots and stadium on a ticket must show their ticket for admission to the parking lot and stadium. Sign in is required for each event.
- Students, parents and guardians are responsible for their own tickets and distribution.
- Lost or stolen tickets may not be replaced.
- **Face coverings (masks) are required at all events inside or outdoors and must be worn at all times during the event.**
- **Social distancing per family unit is required at all events inside or outdoors.**
- **Please stay home if you do not feel well, you are sick or symptomatic.**
- **Sign in at the game is required for all spectators in case the event must be contact traced.**
- **If you are not following guidelines, you may be asked to leave. The order requires that we enforce the guidelines.**
- Everyone must be seated. No standing or congregating. Concessions will not be open.
- Stadium visitor side bleachers are reserved for the band on Friday nights.
- The outside fence areas and wooded areas around the stadium are not approved for spectator(s) and fan(s) to view the games. Only "Ticket" holders will be admitted to the parking areas and/or stadium during game nights.
- SASD will live stream select home events to the best of our ability. Find the livestream links to Vimeo on smethportschools.com
- Cross Country Meet and Golf Match attendance are limited to no more than four (4) family members per student athlete or family unit. Tickets will not be issued for these events.
- A number of limited view parking passes may be made available to the visiting team. These passes will not admit anyone to the stadium but enable people to watch the game from a vehicle outside the stadium.
