Thank you for your continued understanding and support during this unprecedented time. Prior to making any decision for our school, all factors have been weighed and discussed thoroughly. Every careful decision and modification we have made while in distance learning has been under the guidance and direction of the Diocese of San Diego Office for Schools. *Since each Catholic school in our Diocese serves varied communities, we have each been navigating into these uncharted waters to meet the needs of our **own** school community at our own pace.* I am in constant and regular communication with fellow principals and leadership across the Diocese.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

With that being said, the grade reporting for the 4th quarter of this school year for our Holy Trinity School community will focus on a “hold harmless” approach for the duration of distance learning. **Therefore, no student will receive a lower grade than the final overall grade for each subject reported on their third quarter report card.** It is important that we do what is right for our students during this challenging time.

LEARNING PROCESS

This is a unique time and it is new and different for all of us. Our school community focus for this last quarter will be *on the learning process, not just the grades.* All teachers have examined their grade-level curriculum standards and have identified the **major critical concepts** that would yield the most leverage for increasing student achievement and help prepare them for the next grade.

When students receive their final report card, it will reflect their 3rd quarter cumulative grade for each subject and in-class direct instruction. Detailed teacher narratives, based on the assessment of learning of specific and **critical concepts**, will be attached to the final report card.



Gradelink

Assessment is essential to the learning process, however, grading is not. Gradelink will only be used during the 4th quarter for documentation and evidence of learning, and will not be open to students and parents. Students are still required to complete and submit work to their teachers, and will be given feedback to support their progress. In addition, teachers will continue to be available for communication to discuss student progress or parent concerns.

Thank you again for your continued support and cooperation. We are all in this *together and God will see us through because God is good... all the time! And all the time... God is good!*
