Curriculum:

Religion: Leading up to the Lenten season, the students will study the Spiritual and Corporal Works of Mercy, the parts of the Mass, and explore the symbols of our faith. The students will understand and recite the Works of Mercy this month.

Math: Students will understand and solve 2 digit dividend problems with remainders. They will determine multiples and explore properties of prime and composite numbers.

English/Language Arts: The focus for the remainder of the second trimester is the development of writing skills. The students will continue lessons and practice in summarizing, paraphrasing, and the use of transitions as they complete persuasive essays, research reports, and pen pal letters. The students will improve their vocabulary, handwriting skills, and study affixes with workbook practice and applications. The class will read and respond to stories from their literature anthology, *Wonders*, and begin a new class novel with discussions, journal entries, quizzes and activities.

Academic Sharing: Student presentations this month will relate to a topic of their choice. We are thoroughly enjoying getting to know one another *even better!*
