

Dear Holy Trinity School Families,


Happy 60th Day of School!!

in the purple tier counties that are allowed to remain open for in-person learning, are required to close when multiple cohorts have cases or 5% of the staff and students test positive for Covid-19 within a 14-day period. Therefore, if seven individuals from our school community test positive, or multiple cohorts have cases, we will be required to close our school for in-person instruction and transition to full remote distance learning. As mentioned in previous communication, we strongly urge you to remain vigilant and maintain safe and healthy practices while outside of campus with your family, especially with the upcoming Christmas holidays ahead.

We will continue to follow the <u>Big 4</u> guidance to maintain a safe and healthy learning environment for all of our students, teachers, and staff that enter campus because we truly believe in the importance of the whole well-being of our children, in-person learning, Catholic education, and the value of now.


