As the year comes to an end today, and our summer vacation begins, we are eagerly looking forward to reopening school for the 2020-2021 school year as scheduled on Wednesday, August 19. Fortunately, having small class sizes allows us the opportunity to open our classrooms up for daily full in-person instruction, adhering to the CDC guidelines for reopening schools. We will continue to recognize the health and well-being of our school community as our top priority to ensure that our students, teachers and staff can confidently return to a safe and healthy campus that is conducive to learning, work, and faith formation. Therefore, we will continue to assess the appropriate actions and necessary safety protocols and procedures to meet the unique needs and circumstances of our Holy Trinity School community, as well as adhere to the health standards and physical distancing protocols we anticipate being recommended by the California Department of Education and the Health Departments of San Diego and Imperial Counties. 
