AWARD: The District shall award the Contract, if it awards it at all, to the lowest responsive responsible bidder based on:

- A. The sum of the base bid amount, District Contingency, unit costs and alternatives, if any.
- B. After the selection of the low bidder the District may or may not include in the award any or all of the alternatives and unit costs.

BID ACCEPTANCE OR REJECTION: The Board reserves the right to reject any and all bids and/or waive any irregularity in any bid received. BONDS: A bid bond by an admitted surety insurer on the form provided by the District, cash, or a cashier's check or a certified check, drawn to the order of the Saugus Union School District, in the amount of ten percent (10%) of the total bid price, shall accompany the Bid Form and Proposal, as a guarantee that the Bidder will, within **seven (7)** calendar days after the date of the Notice of Award, enter into a contract with the District for the performance of the services as stipulated in the bid.

The successful Bidder shall also be required to furnish a 100% Performance Bond and a 100% Payment Bond, Builder's Risk Insurance if it is awarded the contract for the Work.

SECURITIES: The successful Bidder may substitute securities for any monies withheld by the District to ensure performance under the Contract, in accordance with the provisions of section 22300 of the Public Contract Code.

LABOR LAW: The Contractor and all Subcontractors under the Contractor shall pay all workers on all work performed pursuant to this Contract not less than the general prevailing rate of per diem wages and the general prevailing rate for holiday and overtime work as determined by the Director of the Department of Industrial Relations, State of California, for the type of work performed and the locality in which the work is to be performed within the boundaries of the District, pursuant to sections 1770 et seq. of the California Labor Code.
