Southeastern Career Center Early College

Southeastern Career Center Early College offers students a head start on the rest of their lives by providing the opportunity to earn both a high school diploma and an associate degree, or up to two years of credit toward a bachelor's degree.

Southeastern Early College is sustained by Southeastern Career Center and Vincennes University, who are jointly accountable for student success. Students participate in a finely tuned dual credit program designed to offer an intensive curriculum and increase expectations. The early college promotes an environment conducive to the successful completion of both high school and college.

Funding

- Free/reduced lunch students pay no tuition for most college courses
- Students pay \$25 per credit hour for college courses taught by high school credentialed faculty
- Students pay \$75 per credit hour for courses taught by VU adjunct or distance education faculty
- Textbooks purchased by the school corporation, standard rental fees apply
- Students cover Xmester costs (\$900)

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Uniquely SCCEC

- Established in Fall 2015
- Students earn a Core 40 Diploma with Academic and/or Technical Honors, Industry Recognized Certification, and up to 2 years of college credit toward an Associate Degree
- A supportive, structured, small school learning environment including access to free tutoring, utilization of technology, extracurricular activities/clubs, and internship opportunities
- Teachers/Instructors meet Vincennes University's faculty criteria
- Dual credit courses offered in one of three pathways
- Credits transfer to Indiana colleges and universities
- Distance learning and on-line coursework options available
