

IMPORTANT !!!

Using these tips will aid in a smooth and timely application process.

Crucial information for seniors applying to colleges:

- If applying to large schools (IU, Purdue, UC, IUPUI, etc.) get the applications complete before the end of September for best consideration.
- COMMON APPLICATION – Many schools now use the Common App. If you do applications using the Common App be sure to use Mrs. Ambs' email for the counselor recommendation – lambs@lburg.k12.in.us
- All other application formats use Ms. Kirchgassner's email – rkirchgassner2@lburg.k12.in.us
- Email counselors and any other recommenders a current copy of your resume that includes community service, leadership, other school activities, work history, etc.
- SENDING TRANSCRIPTS – see attached document for instructions to register with Parchment.com. All transcripts should be sent electronically through Parchment.
- SAT/ACT scores – Most schools now want SAT/ACT scores sent from College Board or ACT directly. If you are registering to take either test right away be sure to include the four free schools to receive your scores. If you have not done this, you will need to pay to have scores sent.
- Fee Waivers – Students who qualify for free or reduced lunch and/or 21st Century Scholars are eligible for fee waivers for the SAT and ACT as well as college application fees. See Mrs. Ambs if you need a waiver.
- Friday, August 5th is the regular registration deadline for the ACT being administered at LHS on September 10. For all testing schedule information see the other attached document. This has been announced during the school day.
- Attend the student/parent meeting on Wednesday, August 31 at 6:00 pm in the cafeteria for more information and question/answer session.
