

FREE Grab & Go Meals & Bus Route !

- Aligned with U.S. Department of Agriculture and Arizona Department of Education regulations, Eloy Elementary School District is providing **FREE Grab & Go Meals while schools are offering Remote and Onsite Learning**. Children may stop by a school, or along a bus route to grab a breakfast and lunch meal. This service will be provided during September 2020 through December 31, 2020 or as funds allow.

Details:

- Free to ALL children 18 and under
- Meals offered Monday-Thursday, following EESD Calendar.
- Students DO NOT need to present to take a meal.
- Adult meals are not available.
- Students are not required to attend the Eloy school district.
- Families do not need to register for meals and there are no income requirements.
- Menus vary daily and are subject to change based on food supply.

There is no need to park the car! Families can drive up to the front of the school and a food service staff will provide meals for each student under the age of 18. If you are walking to a school, remember to wait in line with the proper social distancing of 6 feet between one another while grabbing meals.

Meals along Bus Routes

Children may stop by one of bus route for a FREE Grab & Go lunch *and* receive a breakfast and lunch meal.

Monday – Thursday from 8:00am – 11:30am. Times are approximate and may vary by a few minutes to ensure all children are served at each location.

Bus routes will not be operating during scheduled school closure.

Everyone is reminded to practice the recommended social distancing of 6 feet between one another while at the bus stop to receive meals.

Bus Locations & Times:

Buses are traveling to residential areas with a high density of children who traditionally receive meal benefits during the school year. .
