


COVID-19

- * Monitor your health - stay home if you are not feeling well

Immunization PikMyKid - Oakey Campus

Having the proper immunizations for your children to enter and remain in school is a critical piece of student enrollment. When you take your child for his/her shots, please make sure that we get a current copy of these records for our reporting purposes.

If you have a child who will be entering the 7th grade next year, it is mandatory for him/her to have the TDAP shot to be in school. The law will not allow us to admit or keep your child without this shot. The elementary campus is going to be admitting and releasing students with a new process for this year. We are going to be using Designated Car Lines with you notifying the school that you are awaiting your child using a free app on your cellphone.

Students in grades K - 3 will be releasing in the Oakey Car Line. Students in grades 4 - 6 will be releasing in the Bracken Car Line.

Each child will be assigned a car line number. These numbers are to be kept in your car on the dashboard and will be used to identify you and your child for release.

In the next few days, you will receive information for how to register your car so we can help expedite your child getting to you safely each day. We are not going to be letting visitors in the building once school starts to pick up children as we have to follow social distancing guidelines and building occupancy guidelines.
