 December 7, 1970

Meeting called to order at 10:00 A.M. with the following present: Blaine Slade, Chairman, James McDonald, Member, C. L. Haws, Manager, and Kendall Hansen, Attorney. Minutes of previous meeting were approved as published.

Tax Correction Resolution number 8 was approved.

Personal property as rendered by Mr. Slade, the Assessor, was approved and ordered collected.

Clerk was directed to call for bids on gas and heating oil for the coming year. Bids will be opened January 4, 1971, at 10:00 A.M.

Bids will be called for on meals for prisoners and the county printing. These bids will be opened at 10:00 A.M., January 4, 1971.

A letter written to Mrs. Heap, County Recorder, directed her to return the plat for Park Show Low

Final approval was given for St. Michaels Indian School Sub-division Unit I, as agreement was reached on required performance bond.

Original liquor license application number 0301, Ft. Apache Development Corporation, Inc., for Sunrise Park Ski Lodge, located 20 miles east of McNary, was posted to be heard at this time. There being no objection, the Board of Supervisors unanimously approved the application.

John Dixon and Bill Stone, with Continental Field Service Corporation appeared requesting assistance in locating an American Telephone & Telegraph Company co-axial cable across the County from near Witch Wells thence westerly. They were assured that the Board would co-operate and assist any way possible.

The Manager was directed to close the Justice of Peace and Constable offices in Alpine, Vernon, Concho and Ganado as soon after January 1st as possible, and to assist in establishing the new office in Lupton.
