A RESOLUTION

WHEREAS it has been the policy of the County of Apache to provide equal opportunity in its employment practices on the basis of merit and fitness and without discrimination because of race, color, sex, religion, or national origin, and

WHEREAS the County of Apache believes that additional steps are desirable to strengthen and assure equal employment opportunity in every aspect of county personnel practices, and

WHEREAS the County of Apache believes that this goal can best be realized through affirmative action that insures the principles of equal opportunity for all persons in the employment practices of the county:

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the County of Apache does reaffirm its policy to insure equal opportunity in employment for all persons and to prohibit discrimination in employment because of color, race, religion, sex, and national origin, and to promote the full realization of equal employment opportunity through a continuing policy of equal opportunity employment practices in each department of the county and to be an integral part of every aspect of personnel policy and practice in the recruitment, employment, advancement, and treatment of employees and prospective employees of the County of Apache to the maximum extent possible.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the County of Apache will endeavor to assure the full participation in such policies by all persons contracting with or providing services to the County of Apache.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the County of Apache as evidence of its intent to fulfill the principles and procedures necessary for the realization of the objectives herein stated does hereby adopt this resolution of the Board of Supervisors.
