October 5, 1970

Full Board and County Attorney met at 10:00 A.M.

Minutes of previous meetings were approved as published.

Bids for Sheriff's cars were opened and considered. One bid only was presented and therefore, the bid was rejected, and the Clerk ordered to call for bids again. Bid opening to be November 2nd, 1970, at 10:00 A.M.

The Board agreed to use three girls from the High School through the Arizona Cooperative Education program.

A letter containing supplemental information regarding the audit for the year ended June 30, 1970, was signed and sent to the Auditor General.

Original application for Concho Valley Unit 6, a subdivision in Sec. 21, T-12-N, R-26-E, was considered and given first approval.

James A. McDonald was appointed to the Board of Directors of the Arizona State Reclamation Association for the coming year.

Keith Shreeve, County Engineer, recommended that the bond covering construction of roadways in Concho Valley Units 4 & 5 be released as the roads now meet minimum county standards. This action was taken.

White Mountain Paradise, a subdivision located in Sec. 19 & 24, T-11-N, R-24 & 25-E, presented performance bond on roadway construction and asked for final approval on plat presented. This was given and plat was signed.

Tax Correction Resolution numbers 1 through 6, as presented by the Assessor, was inspected and approved and ordered returned to the Assessor.

Stanley Shumway, Chairman of the County Emergency Medical Services Committee, met with the Board and indicated that application #EM 71-003(001) presented to the regional office had been approved October 1, 1970, and asked permission to proceed with the project. This approval was given.
