

<b>Word Recognition, Fluency and Vocabulary (WRF)</b>	<b>Standards</b>
LA.PK.WRFV.1	Pretend to read a book while holding the book right side up, looking at the print and pictures, and turning the pages one at a time from the front to the back.
LA.PK.WRFV.2	Follow printed words as a story is read or a caption of a video is played for ten or more minutes.
LA.PK.WRFV.3	Name objects from a picture book.
LA.PK.WRFV.4	Distinguish print from pictures.
LA.PK.WRFV.5	Name 13 uppercase letters.
LA.PK.WRFV.6	Point to and name 6 letters.
LA.PK.WRFV.7	Tell a story to others while holding a book.
LA.PK.WRFV.8	Tell something that a favorite character does in a story.
LA.PK.WRFV.9	Sing the alphabet song.
LA.PK.WRFV.10	Generate sounds from letters.
LA.PK.WRFV.11	Generate and blend the sounds of letter patterns into recognizable words.
LA.PK.WRFV.12	Imitate simple rhymes by reciting or singing one rhyme.
LA.PK.WRFV.13	Clap out syllables in word songs.
LA.PK.WRFV.14	Match the same letter in different styles.
LA.PK.WRFV.15	Identify the first letter of their name.
LA.PK.WRFV.16	Match the sound that begins their name with the sound that begins another word or name.
LA.PK.WRFV.17	Recognize their name in isolated print.
LA.PK.WRFV.18	Match like letters.
LA.PK.WRFV.19	Use new vocabulary learned from experience.
LA.PK.WRFV.20	Identify 5 common signs or symbols.
<b>Reading Comprehension (RC)</b>	<b>Standards</b>
LA.PK.RC.1	Request or select a favorite story by the title of the book.
LA.PK.RC.2	Tell simple stories from pictures and books.
LA.PK.RC.3	Share own information related to a story event.
LA.PK.RC.4	Tell one thing that happens in a familiar story.
LA.PK.RC.5	Identify the beginning, middle and end of the story.
<b>Literacy Response and Analysis (LRA)</b>	<b>Standards</b>
LA.PK.LRA.1	Act out an imaginary event.
LA.PK.LRA.2	Identify types of print material and ask an adult to read it to them.
LA.PK.LRA.3	Talk about the cover and illustrations prior to the story being read.
LA.PK.LRA.4	Find named pictures or textures in books. Actively look for or keep attending to things that an adult points to, shows or talks about.
LA.PK.LRA.5	Describe the place pictured in a book.
LA.PK.LRA.6	Identify a favorite story and/or Bible story.

<b>Writing Process (WP)</b>	<b>Standards</b>
LA.PK.WP.1	Draws pictures, scribbles, letters and words to generate and express ideas.
LA.PK.WP.2	Use known letters or approximations of letters to represent written language.
LA.PK.WP.3	Associate writing with words.
LA.PK.WP.4	Dictate something for an adult to write down.
LA.PK.WP.5	Position paper for writing.
LA.PK.WP.6	Draw at the top or bottom of the paper, when requested.
LA.PK.WP.7	Read own writing by "reading what it says".
<b>Writing Applications (WA)</b>	<b>Standards</b>
LA.PK.WA.1	Use writing or symbols to share an idea with someone.
LA.PK.WA.2	Give writing to someone as a means of communication.
LA.PK.WA.3	Copy a vertical line from top to bottom.
LA.PK.WA.4	Copy a horizontal line from left to right.
LA.PK.WA.5	Combine strokes and shapes to represent letters.
LA.PK.WA.6	Use the correct grasp of the writing tool.
LA.PK.WA.7	Write letters in strings from left to right.
LA.PK.WA.8	Use different combinations of letters to achieve sounds.
LA.PK.WA.9	Write more than one word correctly.
<b>Listening and Speaking (LS)</b>	<b>Standards</b>
LA.PK.LS.1	Name sounds heard in the environment.
LA.PK.LS.2	Follow one-step and two-step directions without additional prompts.
LA.PK.LS.3	Share information about themselves, upon request.
LA.PK.LS.4	Use language instead of physical force to resolve conflicts, with adult assistance.
LA.PK.LS.5	Engage in reciprocal conversations for 2 to 3 exchanges.
LA.PK.LS.6	Use courtesy words.
LA.PK.LS.7	Identify attributes of family members, pets or self using two familiar attributes.
LA.PK.LS.8	Identify categories of objects in pictures and classify categories of words.
LA.PK.LS.9	Repeat simple five word sentences as presented.
LA.PK.LS.10	Tell stories using five word sentences with nouns, verbs, auxiliary verbs, pronouns and plurals.
LA.PK.LS.11	Express what might happen after the action in a picture. Generalize a solution to a new situation.
