

High School Performing Arts:

This course is a combination class including but not limited to experience in various forms of communication and performance.

Students will:

- Develop their musical, dramatic and production talents;
- Apply the talents they develop to worship and glorify God.

Students will be able to:

- Perform music of moderate difficulty, or diverse genres and styles;
- Use production concepts and techniques (e.g., auditioning, directing and producing) for creating and developing scenes
- Sing accurately, with or without accompaniment, in two and three parts.
- Experiment with different instruments.

The class is designed to be challenging and fun for the introverted as well as extroverted student.

Middle School Chorus

Students build music literacy through performance, theory, sight-singing, sight reading, listening and composing. Vocal development for all students and voice categories is emphasized by focusing on posture, singing technique and choral styles.

Students will:

- Develop their musical talent;
- Apply the talents they develop to worship and glorify God.

Students will be able to:

- Sing choral works with two and three part harmonies;
- Have opportunities to sing in a performance choir for special events;
- Demonstrate knowledge of basic Music Theory and Terms.

Elementary Music Grades 1, 2

This child centered program is designed to integrate the study of all learning styles. To enhance the experience for the student, we perform a major Christmas production, which involves every child and gives all children the chance to audition for major and minor roles, or solos.

Students will:

- Learn to appreciate all styles of music;
- Learn worship songs;
- Perform in the Christmas musical.

Students will be able to:

- Play rhythm instruments;
- Sing in round;
- Identify musical terms and theory;
- Identify the Orchestra Instrument divisions;
- Learn about Wolfgang Amadeus Mozart and Ludwig Von Beethoven

Elementary 3, 4, 5

This child centered program is designed to integrate the study of all learning styles. To enhance the experience for the student, we perform a major Christmas production, which involves every child and gives all children the chance to audition for major and minor roles, or solos.

Students will:

- Learn to appreciate all styles of music;
- Learn worship songs;
- Perform in the Christmas musical.

Students will be able to:

- Play rhythm instruments;
- Identify musical theory and dynamic symbols;

- Speak and ostinato;
- Articulate the arrangement of the Orchestra and identify instruments from each section;
- Identify the historical significance of composers;
- Articulate details from the lives of: Mozart, Beethoven, Bach and Handel.

Kindergarten 3's and 4's

This child centered program is designed to introduce children to music at a beginning level. Included in each lesson is the singing of worship songs and popular as well as traditional children's songs. To enhance the student experience, we perform a Christmas production.

Kindergarten 5's

- Play rhythm instruments;
- Identify and write the whole note, half note, quarter note and eighth note;
- Incorporate movement into music;
- Learn the instrument families;
- Learn about composers: Mozart and Beethoven;
- Learn the Orchestra Instrument Families.
