Course Text: My Perspectives (7th Grade)

Grade calculations: 70% Summative (tests, projects, presentations); 30% Formative (daily work, journals, practice, homework) (Daily journal entries will be graded each quarter for 200 summative points.)

Semester Test: The semester tests will be at the end of the semester and I will have a study guide for students to study well before each test.

Make up work: Students may make corrections to any assignment on which they received less than a 70%. To do so, the student needs to come by my Advisory class within a week of that grade being posted and ask to redo that specific assignment.

Summative Assessment retake policy

Retakes need to be scheduled ahead of time and taken during Advisory.

Availability for extra help:

The best time to come in for additional help would be during Advisory.
