

STEPS TO CREATE COLLEGE BOARD ACCOUNT

- 1. Go to www.collegeboard.org
- 2. It will say sign in or sign up. You will choose Sign UP
- 3. Choose "I am a student"
- 4. Fill in requested information.
- **5.Username and Password**: Sometimes your school will want you to use your school email but either way, <u>BE SURE you write</u> down your username and password, or put it in your 'notes' on your phone. You will be using this repeatedly for multiple College and Career information.

Tips to creating your user name: You will not be able to use symbols such as @.

1st try your first and last name. If you have a common last name, you may have to alter it to your first name and middle name. If that still does not work use your first name and a number.

- **6.Creating your password**: It is best to use something you will easily remember. Remember that Passwords **ARE** case sensitive.
- 7. Security question: You will choose a security question such as "What is your school mascot" No matter which question you choose, MAKE sure your answer is Capitalized. Be sure and <u>write it down</u> or put it in your phone {Notes}
- 8. Subscriptions: If you want to get information about college and scholarships be sure and 'opt in" if you start getting too much email you can always opt out later.

Benefits of opting in:

Stay on top of college-planning milestones and get important reminders about SAT test dates, registration deadlines, test-preparation strategies and score availability. Also, get AP resources and score updates, advice about creating effective applications, and information on searching for colleges and researching the cost.
