This year we have 3 ways your child can be recognized for volunteering. All three look great on a resume!

- **The Barbara James Service award:** This is for HOSA students who complete a minimum of 100 hours in community service hours that are performed for the common good, *AND* related to health will be approved for this event. Please refer to the link below for additional information.

- **HOSA National Service Project:** This year the National Service Project is the National Pediatric Cancer foundation. This is a club award and is bestowed upon chapters that:
 - Contribute a minimum of \$100 or 100 hours of community service in partnership with the organization; and again at \$500 or 500 hours of community service
 - Each hour students spend sewing cancer awareness ribbons, selling, and promoting the foundation will receive 1 hour of community service.
- **The Presidential Volunteer Service Award:** The following events count as volunteer hours:
 - Education, Economic Opportunity, Environmental Stewardship, Veterans and Military Families, Healthy Futures, and Disaster Services.
 - OTHER: adult literacy/education, animal support, arts/culture, civic/community, faith based, family services, immigrant/refugee services, international services, justice/legal, senior services, sport/recreation, and technology.
 - Teens qualify for a bronze at 50 hours, silver at 75, and gold at 100.

Please have your child record the date/time/place (name of agency)/how long they volunteered. Members should bring their timesheets to us so we can enter them into the system.

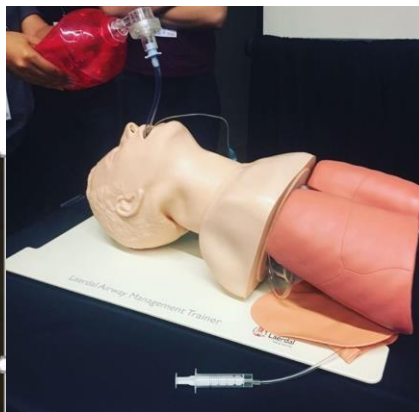
