## Carver's Return to Learning starts remotely

Daily attendance WILL be taken by the teacher and traditional letter grades will be given by the teachers. It is extremely important for your child to participate in their daily learning and stay current on their school work.

Students will stay in remote learning until further notice. Our Carver staff appreciates your support and patience as we continue our Return to Learning for the 2020 - 2021 school year.

## Parent/Teacher Appointments, Map


