For Example

If married couple, filing jointly, donates \$400 (maximum amount allowed) to the Arizona Tax Credit program during the calendar year and:

Owed Arizona State Tax	Paid Arizona State Tax	Amount Owed to AZ or Amount of Refund
\$2,000	\$1,000	Owes \$600
\$1,000	\$2,000	Refund: \$1,400
\$1,000	\$1,000	Refund: \$400
\$0.00	\$0.00	No refund*

If a single person donates \$200 (maximum amount allowed) to the Arizona Tax Credit Program during the calendar year and:

Owed Arizona State Tax	Paid Arizona State Tax	Amount Owed to AZ or Amount of Refund
\$2,000	\$1,000	Owes \$800
\$1,000	\$2,000	Refund: \$1,200
\$1,000	\$1,000	Refund: \$200
\$0.00	\$0.00	No refund*

*Since they have not paid anything to the State, they will not receive a refund.

Arizona School Tax Credits

A Win-Win Opportunity

Arizona Tax Credit

Arizona allows state income taxpayers to receive a tax credit of up to \$400 (\$200 for single filers and \$400 for joint filers) for contributions made to public schools to support extracurricular activities. This tax credit is available to all taxpayers whether or not they have children in the public schools.

The kind of programs you can help fund range from sports and band fees to lab sciences and art projects. Yuma School District One is committed to maintaining these activities for the enjoyment and enrichment of our students. Unfortunately, our funding is not sufficient to offset all of the associated costs. As a result, these programs must depend on fees from students. And that's where you can help.

To claim your Arizona State Tax Credit, just make a donation in an amount you feel comfortable contributing. Whatever amount you give will be offset by a dollar-for-dollar tax credit for the applicable tax year— up to \$400 per tax return! The schools and programs you support are entirely your choice. The law simply states that your donation must go directly to a local school to be used for its extracurricular activities.

By making an Arizona Tax Credit donation, everyone wins. Schools receive the money for extracurricular activities, and donors receive a dollar-for-dollar tax credit (NOT a deduction).

Frequently Asked Questions

Do I take this as a donation or a credit on my Arizona Income Tax Return?

As a credit. Use Form 322 to take the full amount of your donation as a dollar-for-dollar credit against taxes you owe.

What if I don't owe any taxes when I file?

The credit may only be used to the extent it reduces your tax liability to zero. Any unused amounts may be carried forward up to 5 years.

Do I have to have children enrolled in school?

No - any household may donate up to \$400* to be used for extracurricular activities.

As a District One employee, can I donate through payroll deduction?

Yes! Please obtain a form from your payroll specialist.

Do I have to donate \$400*?

No – Any amount you donate up to \$400* can be used as a credit against your tax liability.

What does it cost me?

NOTHING!!!! It is simply your decision to give the money to a school of your choice or the Arizona Department of Revenue.
