**1. CALL TO ORDER**

**4. DISCUSSION ITEMS**

**a. State Public Health Orders for K-12 Education (7/13/20)**

**i. Section 8 (A-D) K-12 schools, colleges, universities, and trade schools may provide on-site instruction to students and allow other use of their facilities under the following provisions:**

- 1. A - Groups shall be limited to 50 people (students and teachers); the facility shall restrict groups of people to 50 in each separate room; the facility may allow more than 50 people in the facility only if each group of 50 is in a room separated by walls from other groups**
- 2. B - Spacing of at least 6 feet between people must be maintained whenever possible; *face coverings shall be worn in situations where 6 feet of separation cannot be maintained***
- 3. C - Six foot spacing of students during transportation to and from the facility must be maintained as much as *practicable***
- 4. D - Hand hygiene must be performed frequently within the facility**
