Remote Learning Expectations
School Winter Closure

The purpose of this document is to outline the expectations and details of remote learning according to the WDE Approved Smart Start Plan if we close school because of winter conditions. The information in this document only applies to school closures, **NOT** late starts or early release for winter conditions.

Smart Start Plan (See District Website)

- Winter Emergency Plan falls under Phase II

When

- When winter conditions won't allow in-person instruction for the majority of the day.
 - Road Conditions
 - No Unnecessary Travel
 - Roads are Closed
 - Building Conditions
 - No Electricity
 - No Heat
 - No Water

Communication

- Parents will be informed a minimum of 12 hours in advance that we are or potentially will be doing remote instruction the following day.
- Chromebooks will be sent home with all students the day prior to remote learning taking place.
- Please email or text your child's teacher if you have questions or concerns during remote learning

Instruction

- Google Classroom and Google Hangout

Schedule

- Remote Learning Phase II requires that we teach a normal schedule for ALL K-12 students.
 - Time: 8:00 am - 4:00 pm
- K-6 Students
 - Required to check-in at 8:00 am with their classroom teacher and follow all expectations for the day.
- 7-12 Student
 - Required to attend every class (Google Meet).
 - Complete all assignments given in Google Classroom for each class.

Attendance

- K-12 attendance will be recorded according to student attendance and participation in each class.

Activities & Athletics

- All Activities and Athletics will be canceled if school is closed due to weather conditions.
