## **Casa Blanca Community School Spring Break Extended Until March 27, 2020 Due To Concerns about COVID – 19**

Dear Casa Blanca Community School Parents and Guardians,  
On Friday March 13th the Casa Blanca Community School Board of Trustees voted to extend the school Spring Break for students. Spring Break will now end on March 27<sup>th</sup>. The Board made this decision out of an abundance of caution and concern for our students and our Casa Blanca families.

Today, there was a meeting with Gila River Indian Community Tribal Education, Community schools and members of tribal council and Governor Steven Lewis. Community schools are submitting information to the Community about plans during the State school closure.

Casa Blanca has submitted our plans that include: Notifying parents and guardians through mail, school website, and social media: holding all parent conferences by phone; limiting access to the campus by the public; planning for deep cleaning and sanitizing the school and busses and most importantly – Student Nutrition Services.

If this information changes I will update the school website and FACEBOOK page in real time.

### **STUDENT NUTRITION**

On Tuesday March 24, 2020 Casa Blanca Community School will serve “Grab and Go” breakfast/ lunch food bags to students 18 years old and younger at designated sites in Districts Four and Five and door to door for Casa Blanca Community school students in District 3. We are authorized to distribute 500 Grab and Go bags per day (CBCS students are prioritized). Grab and Go bags will typically include: a sandwich, fruit, milk and cereal and fruit for breakfast the next day. Each bag will meet the USDA lunch and breakfast requirement.

Casa Blanca school busses, drivers and staff will be delivering the meals. Busses will be in the designated area and distribute approximately 50 meals at each site daily Monday through Friday until schools reopen. Students ages 5 – 18 may come by the table and pick up a bag to take home to eat. **The child must pick up the lunch at the designated site. All adults must be accompanied by the child/ children that are picking up the Grab and Go Bag.** One Grab and Go Bag per child age 5 – 18.
