Old Business/Updates:

*Introduction of those present and PTSO board members.

*Kristi gave an overview of the NBMS PTSO Purpose. The goal is to support the teachers and staff, and the student group activities. The focus of the school is for the student activities and groups to do the majority of activities, with PTSO mainly focusing on supporting teachers and staff, and purchasing items to assist them in their classrooms.

Rachel makes a motion to approve \$100.00 for the items requested. Jennifer seconds the motion; motion carries with 1 opposed. Sean donated \$86.00 to be used to purchase the remaining items requested for the library so that the total allowed is \$186.00

Cori is working on trying to get another Keurig machine donated. We will continue to work on ideas on how to help beautify and better use this space.
