<u>Description:</u> This course is an elective course. The students in this class are the governing board. They will be responsible for the smooth running of the school activities. Students will approve all club activity which occurs on campus, assemblies, fundraisers, dances and more. Students must be energetic, positive, motivated, and willing to go the extra mile in service to their school and peers. Community service is also required for ALL students each semester! Students must be positive role models on campus and can/will be removed for poor academics and/or behavioral issues.

<u>Attendance:</u> Since you are responsible for school activities, it is absolutely necessary that you attend every class session. Decisions are difficult to make when there is no quorum. Grades are given on class and activity participation; therefore, it is important to be in attendance. For every 4 absences (not school related), students will be asked to complete I hour of extra community service time to make up for work missed in class. This does not include school related absences.

<u>Grading</u>: It should be understood that just being an elected official you do <u>NOT</u> get an automatic A. To be fairly evaluated there will be several requirements that must be met to obtain a grade for this course. The following will be used to determine this:

- -Peer evaluations by your own committee members.
- -Weekly assessments by instructors.
- -Participation in activities outside of the classroom (homecoming, dances, spirit weeks etc).
- -Community service each semester
- -Written reflections/papers from class lessons
- -Notebook containing proper paperwork from ALL committee/class work

100%-90% = A

89%-80% = B

79% - 70% = C

69%-60% = D

Below 60% = F

Additionally, as school leaders, good grades must be maintained in all coursework to remain "eligible" for the course. At marking periods, any student with a D or F in any class, or with a quarter or semester grade point average lower than a 2.8, will be removed from class (to ALC during 3<sup>rd</sup> hour) and excluded from participation in Student Council related activities until grades improve. Student Council is a huge commitment, but ultimately grades come first. If grades do not improve by the next marking period, student will vacate their StuCo position, be graded out with an F, and have a schedule change.

#### Consequences:

4th Infraction: Written referral to administration
