



## **The Linda F. Carr Memorial Scholarship**

### Who was Linda Carr?

Mrs. Carr was a beloved teacher, principal, and administrator for the Queen Creek Unified School District from 1997 through her retirement at the end of the 2012-2013 school year. Prior to her arrival in Queen Creek, Mrs. Carr taught in and was the principal of several school districts in northern New York State.

This scholarship was created following her passing on May 30, 2014, to ensure her legacy of excellence and caring and to afford the opportunity for a young person, in the district, to continue on with his/her education at an institution of higher learning.

### **CRITERIA**

#### Who is Eligible?

This scholarship is only open to seniors at Queen Creek High School. Seniors who are planning on furthering their education by attending a 2 or 4 year college or an institute of higher learning are encouraged to participate. Preference will be for a student determined to continue their education despite their financial uncertainty.

#### Theme:

The theme of this scholarship is strength of character and perseverance against the odds.

Amount of scholarship:

The scholarship amount is **\$1,000.00**, which is dependent on donations and funds in the account. It is also possible for more than one student to win a scholarship, depending on the available monies. So, all eligible students are encouraged to apply for the scholarship.

Scholarship must be used for the Fall 2020 semester and will expire November 30, 2020.

Application Requirements:

All criteria must be met and a completed packet submitted in order to qualify for the scholarship. If a packet is missing a piece of criteria, the candidate will not be eligible for the scholarship.

1. The application must be completed in its entirety. No handwritten applications will be accepted.
2. A copy of the applicant's **High School Transcript** must accompany the application.
3. Each applicant will submit **Two Letters of Recommendation**. Both letters are to be from current/prior teachers or counselors.
4. **Application deadline is April 13, 2020, at 8:00 AM** via email to [cprice@qcusd.org](mailto:cprice@qcusd.org). Packets turned in beyond that date will not be eligible for the scholarship.
