

Queen Creek Unified School District – Title I Summer School

Dear QCUSD Middle School Parents and Students,

Newell Barney Middle School, Queen Creek Middle School, and Eastmark High School have a policy that highly recommends students with a final grade of a “F” in Math or ELA to attend summer school to replace the failing grade with a “D”. At this time your child is currently failing or is in danger of failing in Math and/or ELA and will be recommended to attend Title I summer school session at Queen Creek Middle School. Summer school will run Mondays-Thursdays from June 1st-18th, 2020. School begins at 8:00 am and will end at 12:00 noon.

Summer school this year will be done through direct instruction at Queen Creek Middle School. Students who earned an F in Math or ELA for their final grade will take both an ELA class **AND** a Math class. Students will have each class for 2 hours, Monday through Thursday, from June 1st-18th. The classes will cover important standards from the school year, therefore, students who were in 6th grade for the 2019-2020 school year will be in 6th grade summer school and so on. These standards will help to replace some of the concepts that your child may have struggled with and will also provide the foundation for them to be successful next year.

Pending space, if your child ends up with a D for the semester in Math or ELA, QCUSD would strongly recommend that they attend summer school so that we can support them in these core subject areas and prepare them for next year. Please be aware that attending summer school for a student who earns a D is only if there is space available and will **not** result in a grade change.

If you would like to secure your student's attendance in summer school, please fill out the included permission form and medical release. Regular attendance is extremely important, especially during summer school. The maximum amount of days that a student may be absent and still pass summer school is two.

For this learning experience to be productive, parents and students are asked to contribute by helping with the following school rules. Those students that do not adhere to the following will **not** be eligible to participate.

- Students must follow all school rules. This includes having a school identification card available and not using electronics including phones unless directed to by the teacher.
- Be Kind, Be Respectful, and Show Integrity
- Students who do not come prepared tend to disrupt the learning process of those around them. Most supplies will be provided, but students should come with a pencil and pen.

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You **MUST** provide transportation for your child to and from summer school. Breakfast and lunch will **NOT** be provided.

Please have your child arrive by 7:55 am each day of summer school so that they are in class and ready to learn by 8:00. Adult supervision will be from 7:45 am until 12:15 pm. Students need to be dropped off and picked up in the lane on the south side of QCMS. The first day of school will be June 1, the teachers will be outside to organize the students and let them know with which teacher they will start the day.
