FIELD HOUSE NAMED AFTER QCUSD SUPPORTER

The Monte Nevitt Field House at Queen Creek High School

QUEEN CREEK, AZ, Dec. 17, 2015 — The Monte Nevitt Field House at Queen Creek High School is more than just a weight room. "It represents the growth, the change, and the overall transformation that the student athlete experiences during those critical high school years," stated former QCUSD board member Monte Nevitt, during his recent visit to the facility.

The Monte Nevitt Field House is located on the south end of the high school near the football field. It features a variety of equipment, and locker rooms within a large gym space. The Field House flooring, which is responsive to multiple sports use, and multiple equipment machines, were installed as a result of voter-approved bond dollars.

"I was initially greatly honored to have the field house named after me. Over these last couple of years I feel even more so. I'm personally grateful to see the community continue to support the strength and conditioning program at the high school through the passage of bond money to help maintain the facility. The work that takes place in this weight room, serves as the core/foundation of successful high school athletes and teams that our community has experienced over the years," Nevitt said. This facility benefits students from all extracurricular/sports activities offered at Queen Creek High School.


This isn't the first time Nevitt has shown his support for the Queen Creek Unified School District. Nevitt served for over 16 years (1992-2008) on the Governing Board, during a dynamic time of growth and helped build QCUSD into one of Arizona's best performing school districts.

Nevitt remembers that Coach Bean used to teach her athletes that the price of championships was paid in the off season. "What takes place in that weight room during the cold of winter and during the heat of the summer – far from the eyes of the cheering crowd in the gym or stadium is of far greater importance than the sixty minutes under the lights on Friday night. But, it's not just about a football player in his struggle to gain the power needed to take the game to the other side of the line of scrimmage," Nevitt said. "The slow and methodical emergence of self-confidence that results from dedication in that weight room spills over into every other endeavor that the Queen Creek athlete later pursues in life."
