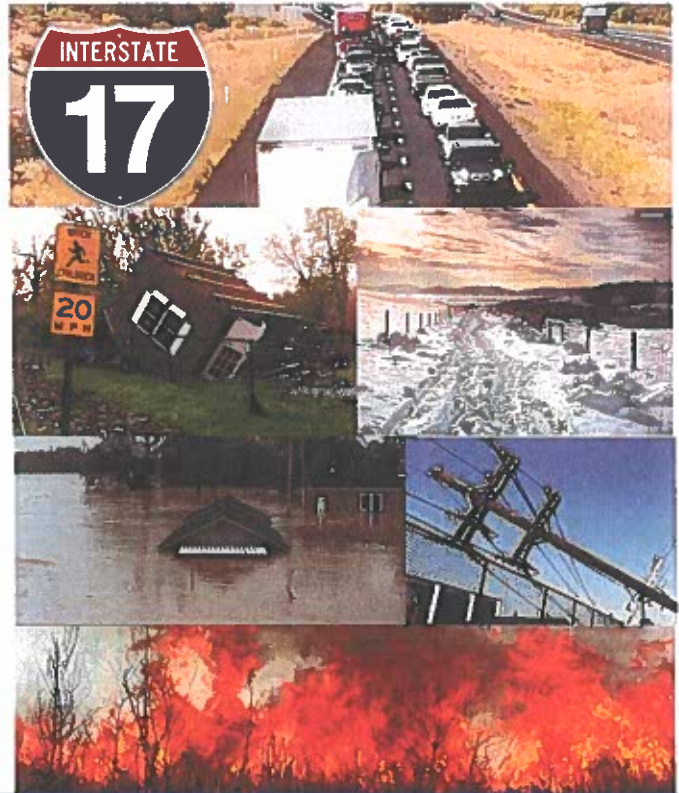

Important Tips:

- ◆ Know Location of Electric Meter/Shut-off
- ◆ Know Location of Gas Meter/Wrench to Close
- ◆ Know Location of Water Main/Shut-off
- ◆ Know Two Evacuation Paths from Every Room
- ◆ Know Where Your Family Will Gather Outside the Home
- ◆ Know Who to Contact When Away from Home

Be Prepared to be Self-Sufficient for 72 Hours by Creating and Maintaining a Home Survival Kit:

- ◆ First Aid Kit
- ◆ Portable Radio/Batteries
- ◆ Flashlight/Batteries
- ◆ Water (1 gal. per person/day)
- ◆ Food/Can Opener
- ◆ Cooking Equipment
- ◆ Resealable Plastic Bags
- ◆ Important Documents
- ◆ Sanitation/Hygiene Supplies
- ◆ Bucket/Simple Hand Tools
- ◆ Shoes/Clothes/Blankets
- ◆ Prescriptions/Glasses
- ◆ Baby Supplies
- ◆ Fire Extinguisher
- ◆ Duct Tape
- ◆ Pet Supplies

Create a Car Survival Kit:

- ◆ Food/Bottled Water
- ◆ Blankets/Jackets/Shoes
- ◆ First Aid Kit/Medications
- ◆ Flashlight/Batteries

"Code Red" Emergency Notifications:

Yavapai County Sheriff's Office uses the "Code Red" Emergency Notification System (ENS) to notify residents of warnings, alerts or evacuations in their specific area during an emergency.
