21<sup>st</sup> CCLC is a state funded program, under No Child Left Behind, designed to provide extended learning and enrichment opportunities to students and parents. On Monday through Wednesday from 3:15 PM-4:30 PM students from Tier 2 will be invited for additional tutoring to improve academic achievement. Fridays the program is open to all students. It will run from 8 AM-3:30 PM. 21<sup>st</sup> CCLC activities will be held throughout the school year and in the summer.

**COST:** The Program is offered to all students ***free*** of cost. There may be a small materials and supply fee for certain activities and/or field trips.

**SNACKS and MEALS:** A free after school snack will be provided for all registered participants in accordance with USDA guidelines. Free breakfast and lunch will be served on Fridays.

**TRANSPORTATION:** The district provides a **4:30 PM** bus Monday-Wednesday and two bus runs on Friday, one in the morning and one in the afternoon at 3:30.

**HOLIDAYS:** There will be ***no*** programming on school holidays.

**REGISTRATION:** *Students MAY NOT begin the program until all of their registration materials are received.*

**GENERAL RULES FOR PARTICIPANTS:** All school rules will be enforced.
