

Greetings, Families of Addenbrooke Classical Academy High School.

Important Please Read:

You have received an email from the district about district schools moving to 100% in person schooling. This change for the district does not impact Addenbrooke Classical Academy. We have already been at 100% in-person schooling this year, with the option for fully remote. Essentially the district schools are just now moving to the model we adopted at the start of the year.

Clarification:

Many district schools have been running an every-other-day schedule where students are remote one day and in-person the next. Jeffco is now going to move students to full-time (M-Th) in-person learning. Jeffco is continuing to offer the fully remote option as well, which will remain long-term, even beyond this school year.

Addenbrooke will continue the synchronous full-time learning model we have held all year. Those who attend in person will continue to attend, and those who are remote will continue to join the class via Zoom.
